I am pleased to inform you that the Society is prepared to award an amount up to \$250 for travel support for your attendance at the AMS Sectional Mathematics Meetings, Sept 10-11, 2011, Cornell University, Ithaca, NY. No need to reply again if you have already done so.] It is especially important to let us know immediately (within three days) if you are unable to accept the award, so that we may reallocate the funds to those on our waiting list.

Funds from this grant may be used for reimbursement of travel and subsistence (that is, hotel and food) expenses incurred in connection with your attendance at the meeting; this reimbursement will only be available AFTER the travel has ended. No check will be issued until a signed voucher is received from you, after the meeting. All arrangements for reimbursement from your school should be conducted on your own. You are responsible for making your travel arrangements to the meeting.

Everyone being reimbursed under this program must register for the meeting and submit, with the travel voucher, the meeting registration badge obtained during the meeting, or a copy of it.

- . after the meeting submit your signed travel voucher, with badge, by mail to the AMS
